

HIRERS MUST:

- Be sensible & responsible
- Avoid shallow/rocky waters
- Avoid oyster leases
- Keep boat clean and tidy
- Remove all rubbish from boat
- Return to the marina by due time (indicated on receipt)
- Travel slowly and carefully around marina

HIRERS MUST NOT:

- Exceed 0.05 BAC limit
- Overload the boat
- Travel through moored boats
- Gut &/or scale fish in boat
- Exceed Hire Limits (see other side)
- Tow other boats, kayaks, ski tubes etc.

FAILURE TO OBEY THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN A FORFEIT OF YOUR DEPOSIT.

Anchor use:

1. Ensure anchor and rope are clear of arms/legs/belongings
2. Lower anchor into water
3. When rope is slack continue to allow more rope out
4. Tie off rope on bow of boat



Engine Starting/Running operations:

1. Ensure gear lever is in neutral (vertical) position.
2. Turn key once, proceed to turn again and hold until motor starts. When started release key.
3. Move gear lever in direction you wish to travel (forward or reverse)
4. Accelerate by pushing gear lever forward or back to increase and decrease speed.
5. Steer boat by turning steering wheel clockwise and anti clockwise.
6. To stop engine, engage neutral and turn key to off position
7. If high pitched alarm sounds, stop engine, call marina.



Safety:

- Maximum 6 people on board (including children)
- Lifejackets are provided for each person
- Children 12 and under must wear lifejacket at all times
- If consuming alcohol do not exceed 0.05 BAC limit
- Bailing bucket provided
- A life jacket must be worn if solo

In the event of an emergency:

1. Put life jackets on
2. Notify marina (9456 7000)
3. Call '000' for a medical emergency
4. Call '112' if out of reception for an emergency
5. Call surrounding boats for assistance


